# Dear Fellow Companions of the Way,

This Sunday, December 20th, will be my last Sunday with you, as the time has come for me to say farewell. Much has been accomplished in the past 13+ months and your Pastor Nominating Committee (PNC) is moving forward expeditiously. Outstanding new staff including Tarci Matthews, Stephanie Brader, Kili Wenburg, and Carlos Santos are now serving wonderfully. Our staff changes have reduced our expenses \$86,000. We are about to realize a new state of the art audio and visual system in the sanctuary, along with much needed repairs to buildings and grounds thanks to special gifts. The session established a new communications and technology committee this year and held "listening sessions" with the congregation. A new temporary pastor will begin here January 1st, and in the meantime I have lined up Adam White, Lee Wigert, and Bryce Weibe to be guest preachers on consecutive Sundays, beginning December 27<sup>th</sup>.

In the coming months you will be meeting your next installed pastor! Please welcome him or her personally and with prayer, patience and partnership. I hope you will welcome him/her **personally.** Find or make a nametag to wear so he/she can quickly learn your name, as he/she will have hundreds of new names to learn. You might also drop him/her a personal note of welcome. I hope you will welcome him/her **prayerfully.** The best gift you could ever give your pastor is to pray for him/her daily! I hope you will welcome him/her **patiently.** I have often heard the phrase, "when the new pastor gets here." People are ready to move on, but take some time to get to know each other, and give him/her some time to become oriented to life at First Presbyterian Church. I hope you will welcome him/her as **partner** in ministry. He/she will not be called to First Presbyterian Church, Hastings to do ministry for you, but to join you as a partner and co-laborer in ministry for God. And as you welcome him/her, remember to pray for all your church staff and officers.

In closing, Mimi joins me in expressing our deep appreciation for all your kindness during our pilgrimage with you. The relationships we have forged here have greatly enriched our lives. As we move on to our new calling in northwest Virginia, we will hold you in our best thoughts and fervent prayers.

We pray that you will continue to till and irrigate the soil of your souls so that the fruit of the Spirit may grow in great abundance in you. I leave with a deep sense of pastoral affection and love for each of you, and "I pray that you may have the power to comprehend, with all the saints, what is the breadth and length and height and depth, and to know the love of Christ that surpasses knowledge, so that you may be filled with all the fullness of God." (*Ephesians 3:18-19*)
