Our goal is to provide food where there is a high need, but resources are limited. The mobile food pantry is available to all <u>free of charge</u>. The institutions providing the food are equal opportunity providers.

NOTICE: Lining up before 9:30 AM is not allowed

Beginning in December, we will randomize the order you receive food, based on last name. Below are the rules that will apply. Please ask if you have questions.

Because of the high volume of families we serve, please comply with the following rules:

- DO NOT ARRIVE EVEN ONE MINUTE EARLY. YOU WILL BE TURNED AWAY.
- · Photo I.D. is required for arrival time verification only.
- Your LAST name determines when you may come, park, and receive a number to go through the pantry. The last
 name of the driver of the car is the only name used. If your last name is hyphenated, it is the first last name
 (Smith-Jones is "S"). If you have more than one last name, it is the last-last name (Smith Allan Jones is "J").
- Those walking or with special circumstances with be handled case by case.
- . I.D.'s are checked and numbers distributed at the parking entrance (Lincoln and 7th St.)
- One number per household (household = one address). You must have a number to register inside.
- If you carpool, arrival time is determined by the driver's I.D.
- Your number determines when you go through the pantry to collect food. Once you have a number you may
 wait in the Annex or leave and return closer to your distribution time.
- Please do not park at either First Presbyterian or First United Methodist Churches.
- · Hastings Police patrol the area.
- We cannot guarantee that we will not run out of every items before everyone is served.
- Please obey all traffic laws including no stopping in streets and no blocking traffic lanes.
- Please follow instruction of volunteers! They are experienced and doing their best. We are here to help you!
- If you are picking up food for another person, they must fill out a proxy pickup form.
- There is food for everyone. ALL ARE WELCOME.
- USDA income limits apply to some foods.
- . I.D. is for arrival time verification only.
- Please bring boxes, coolers, or other containers for your food.



Please note the times to arrive. This assures that we are as fair to everyone as we can possibly be. DO NOT COME EARLY!!!
