LIGHTING OF THE ADVENT WREATH AND CHRIST CANDLE Stein/Borrell Family Today we celebrate Christmas Eve and the birth of the Christ Child! We light all of the candles on the advent wreath. First, we lit the candle of hope. Next, we lit the candle of love. Then, we lit the candle of joy. Finally, we lit the candle of peace.

Today, we light the center candle which represents Jesus Christ. When we light this candle, we remember Jesus' birth. Our waiting has ended!

When we look at the center candle, we remember that God sent Jesus to give hope, peace, joy, and love to all people.

Outside of Bethlehem the shepherds saw a great light and heard the voices of angels. They traveled to the manger and saw the baby Jesus.

These trips provide more opportunities for you to **share the love of Christ** and learn where God is at work around the world!

Our church seeks to engage our **hearts** and our **minds**, so we offer **amazing learning opportunities**. Come to **Sunday School** for all ages at 9:15am to hear engaging speakers and dig into the Bible to learn about what it means to you. We always have at least two **classes for adults** to deepen your faith and expand your mind, in addition to classes for children and youth. Come to our "**Wednesday Night Live**" program for 4-12 year olds from 4-6:45pm for bible study, rec time, music and dinner. We also have an **active youth group** for 6th-12th graders from 7:30-8:15pm every Wednesday night.

Do you like to make **music**? Come join our Chancel Choir, play in the handbell choir, join the praise band, or bring your kids to our children and youth choirs or handbell groups.

Join us for **Sunday morning worship** at 8:30 for a service which alternates between a contemplative "Taize-style" worship and a contemporary "praise-style" worship. Or join us at 10:30 for a more traditional worship experience with our glorious Chancel Choir, organ music, and **engaging bible-based preaching**.

At First Presbyterian Church of Hastings, we are a **community of hope** where you will always hear a message of hope proclaimed.
