Another successful Go & Serve Mission Trip to Camp Courageous in Monticello, Iowa (July 14-21, 2018) is in the history book!

Hey Folks,

It's your friendly neighborhood Associate Pastor writing to give you a little information about our recent Go and Serve Trip. Another year has brought us another year of blessings on Go & Serve. From July 14-21 we traveled with a group of 14 youth and 6 adult sponsors to Camp Courageous in Monticello, Iowa.

Camp Courageous is a camp setting specifically designed to serve individuals of all ages living with disabilities. The facility is open year-round to provide weekend programming and respite care but during the summer they organize weeks of camp for those they serve.

We volunteered during a week of youth camp and spent our time assisting the Camp Courageous staff as they worked to provide a wonderful experience to their campers. We climbed trees, sang silly songs, swam, canoed, fished, cooked over a campfire, rode trains, ziplined, and even went bowling.

It truly was a gift to see the care the counselors offered to their campers but it was even more amazing to watch the hearts of our own youth grow by performing acts of love and justice for those they encountered throughout the week.

Honestly, it's too bad you weren't there as because you'd beaming with pride if you had been able to witness the way our youth embodied the love of God during our time at Camp Courageous.
