PASTOR GREG

Dear First Presbyterian Church family:

Before coming to Hastings, I worked in Louisville at the Presbyterian Church headquarters. I was the general manager of Presbyterian World Mission, which meant that I helped to oversee and support all of our Presbyterian mission workers serving around the world. When I was there, we had approximately 200 mission workers serving in over 40 countries.

First Presbyterian Church of Hastings is no stranger to Presbyterian World Mission and supporting mission workers around the world. I was reading some old Session minutes from the 1900s and realized that this church has a history of more than 100 years of support for mission workers. Some of our Go and Serve trips have also been to international destinations, where we had the opportunity to interact with mission workers and to be mission workers for a week!

Not all of us can be mission workers that serve overseas, but as a church we recognize how vital and important that work is. It allows us to support the work that God is doing around the world, and it helps us to fulfill the Great Commission: *Then Jesus came to them and said*, "All authority in heaven and on earth has been given to me. Therefore go and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, and teaching them to obey everything I have commanded you. And surely I am with you always, to the very end of the age."

We have had a number of missionaries come to visit us here in Hastings over the years. Since I started more than two years ago, we have met missionaries from Malawi, South Korea, and Lebanon. We are blessed with two upcoming opportunities to meet more of our Presbyterian mission workers.

On Monday, August 5, Charles and Melissa Johnson will be with us. They serve as agricultural and education workers in Zambia. Jessica and I will host a potluck at our house that evening, and we invite you to join us. You can find more details about this in the Home Page.

The weekend of October 26, we will have a visit from Mark and Miriam Adams-Maldonado. They serve on the US-Mexico border as our Presbyterian mission workers. They will join us in worship and then for a potluck after worship on Sunday, October 27.

I encourage you to take advantage of these opportunities to meet our mission workers and learn about the work that God is doing through them in different parts of the world. We are blessed to be part of a denomination that supports global mission work, and we are blessed that these global mission workers can come visit us in Nebraska and share their stories.

Project Homeless Connect (the July Communion Offering) was held on July 25th. First Presbyterian Church was well represented on the coordinating committee with Lenae Hall, Jan Ham, Denny Storer and Sharon Brooks as a navigator. There were 183 families served with 496 registered individuals. Of those, there were 194 youth, ages 0-16, and 119 adults (family/roommates), 25 and over.

August Communion Offering is Food4Thought, a non-profit food assistance program run by Hastings College students and assisted by campus and community volunteers. Each week, volunteers pack and deliver bags of food to Hastings Public elementary schools. These bags are then sent home on Fridays with students whose families qualify for the Free and Reduced Lunch Program. Currently, Food4Thought provides supplemental meals designed to feed a family of six for two days to over 100 local families.

Christianity in Action in Zambia Join us Monday, August 5th at 6:00 pm – 8:00 pm for a presentation and barbecue at the Allen-Pickett Home

Don't miss this rare opportunity to hear first hand about Christianity in action in Zambia from Mission Co-Workers, Charles and Melissa Johnson.

Charles and Melissa Johnson have been invited to help the Church of Central Africa, Presbyterian Synod of Zambia, expand its ministry of community development and food security. A major focus of Charles's position as Development Specialist is teaching sustainable agriculture to students at Chasefu Theological College and developing Chasefu Farm. The farm feeds the students, trains smallholders in sustainable agriculture, and generates revenue to support CTC and the farm itself. Melissa serves in the Health Department as Health Education Programs Facilitator. She is responsible for working with health-related stakeholders to identify important needs and gaps in the general population's health education and to facilitate training programs. "We pray that our work in Zambia will see new partnerships created that will benefit those we serve alongside," say Melissa and Charles.
