A mobile pantry is a traveling food pantry that delivers food to families in need through a one day distribution. Our goal is to provide food where there is a high need, but resources are limited. The mobile food pantry is available to all <u>free of charge</u>. The institutions providing the food are equal opportunity providers.

Those interested in receiving food should bring boxes or bags. (Plastic bags can be brought to the church office and donated to the cause.) Those interested in volunteering with the event should simply show up on the date of the next distribution and check in at the volunteer sign-in table. Volunteer shifts are 9:30-12:00 and 12:00-2:00.



Project Homeless Connect is a oneday, all-volunteer led event to connect homeless, near homeless, or those who are struggling to needed resources and services, and to raise public awareness of homelessness and the needs of those who often may go unseen. The mission of PHC is about welcoming all as neighbors into the life of the community, changing the way resources are accessed, and offering positive results for those in need.

Project Homeless Connect-Hastings will be 10-4pm, Thursday, July 25 at 1st St Paul's Lutheran. Last year we served 432 guests, including 212 children. This year we anticipate serving 450. We'll have 40 vendors, with increased emphasis on geriatric and pediatric services.

Volunteers are the foundation of our event! We are seeking at least 150 volunteers, but more welcome! Navigators to assist people as they visit vendors are a high priority, as interpreters. are Please visit phchastings.org for more information about volunteer opportunities, to sign up, or to learn more about the event.
