

Dear First Presbyterian Church Family

The pledge card has an estimate for your total pledge flowed by a second line that reads “Per Capita estimate of giving” of \$33.50/member.

Per Capita is the money that we give to the Presbytery, Synod and national church office called the Office of the General Assembly. \$19.15 of it stays in our Presbytery in Central Nebraska, \$5.40 goes to our regional Synod and \$8.95 is sent on to the national church office. As a local church, we benefit from being part of the Presbyterian Church (USA) denomination. For example, when we were doing flood relief, we received \$2000 from Presbyterian Disaster Assistance to help with our flood relief efforts. That was funded by the national denomination and facilitated by our Presbytery. We also benefit from the sending of mission workers around the world, and we learn from them when they come back to visit us. We have had visitors this year from Lebanon, Zambia, Zimbabwe, and Mexico. This is part of what it means to be a “connectional church”.

As you calculate your pledge, I encourage you to include an extra \$33.50 per family member to help us cover the per capita that we send on to the Presbytery, Synod and Office of the General Assembly. Thank you! – Pastor Greg
