NOTABLE NOTES FROM PASTOR GREG

Dear First Presbyterian Church Family:

I feel so blessed to be serving such a generous congregation, and a God of abundance! Thank you for all the many ways you support our church, including through your financial giving.

You may remember that we ended 2020 with a budget surplus of \$90,000. Historically when we end the year with a surplus, we put that money into our endowment. In early 2021, one of our Trustees

Associate Pastor: Damen Jensen-Heitmann suggested that we take the surplus and spend it on local mission and ministry, particularly trying to help those who have been negatively impacted by COVID-19 and the economic slowdown. The Trustees approved this idea in theory and forwarded it to the Session for approval.

Session voted to use the surplus in this way:

- 1/3 of the surplus (\$30,000) into savings/endowment
- 1/3 of the surplus (\$30,000) towards improvements at the PEACE Center which is used for ministry and mission that benefits those impacted by COVID-19 like the United Harvest Mobile Food Pantry, the Hastings Food Pantry, and other local ministries
- 1/3 of the surplus (\$30,000) spent directly on local mission and ministry in 2021

We thought about how to spend the \$30,000 on local mission and ministry and decided to let our Mission Committee facilitate that decision. The Mission Committee wants input from the congregation about the best ways to spend these resources, so they have created a simple application process. On the next page of the newsletter, you will find a one page application. If you know of a worthy organization that is in need of financial resources please fill out the application and return it to the Mission Committee or the church office by October 1.



CONGRATULATIONS TO SHARON BROOKS for being inducted into the Nebraska Broadcasters Association Hall of Fame!



Sharon began her career as a part-time news and weather reporter at KHAS-TV in 1973 while a student at Hastings College ('74); she was then hired full-time by KHAS-TV in 1974.

In 1976 she was the first woman in the state of Nebraska to hold the title of News Director at a television station.

Sharon began a teaching career at Hastings College in 1979 and stayed until she retired in 2016. During this time, she was instrumental in designing the broadcast program at HC as well as assisting architects in the design of the Gray Center to suit the needs of such a program. Sharon has influenced and touched the lives of thousands of students as well as being a well-respected

colleague and peer in our community.

Our next **SYNOD FALL GATHERING** is just around the corner, this September in Minden. We will be assembling CWS School Kits (Christian World Service) and have set up a table for donations in the Memorial Room. The desired items are listed below, anything you can supply is appreciated:

CWS School Kits

School kits give children in impoverished schools, refugee camps, or other difficult settings some of the basic tools for learning.



🕞 Here's what you'll need

- One pair of blunt scissors removed from the package (rounded tip, only)
- Three 70-count bound notebooks or notebooks totaling 200-210 pages (no looseleaf or filler paper)
- One 30-centimeter / 12" ruler
- One hand-held pencil sharpener removed from the package
- One large eraser (no pencil cap erasers)
- Six new, unsharpened pencils with erasers (please remove pencils from the package)
- One box of 24 crayons (only 24)
- One 12"x14" to 14"x17" finished size cotton or lightweight canvas bag with handles (solid color or kid-friendly fabric, no logos, reusable shopping bags or backpacks)

All items must be packed inside of the bag. The MyShopAngel website has an affordable CWS Kit bag for bulk purchase. Visit cwskits.org/bag to order. Or, download our school bag pattern and make your own!

Optional: Loose school kit items may be placed in a large Ziploc type bag to keep them together. Remove the air, seal the bag and place inside of the cotton/canvas bag.

Value: \$15.00 Processing fee: \$2.00 per kit


