The Omicron Surge and our response

Dear First Presbyterian Church Family:

22 months ago, in March of 2020, we made the difficult decision to suspend in-person worship due to this new disease called COVID-19. Fortunately, because the church has invested in broadcast ministry, we were able to easily connect and provide a way for people to continue worshiping and participating with us through our radio, television, and live-streaming. Thanks be to God for all of the amazing saints who have supported that ministry over the years!

11 months ago, in February 2021, we restarted in-person worship with many precautions in place including face masks, social distancing, and a UV light filtration system in our air handler in the sanctuary. It was such a joy to be back in-person in our sanctuary, and to continue our robust broadcast ministries as well!

Over the last 11 months, we have been slowly adding back in-person ministries and opportunities for fellowship. First it was committee meetings, Youth Group, and Confirmation Class. Then we did Vacation Bible School. In August we restarted all of our Wednesday night programs along with our Sunday School classes and our music programs. We made it through the Delta surge in cases this Fall and continued forward with prudence and caution. We were able to hold in-person Christmas Eve services this year, which was a true joy and delight.

Today we are facing yet another surge in cases from the Omicron variant. Session, the leadership council of the church, met last night to discuss the risk posed by the rapid spread of this insidious disease. Prior to the meeting, your church elders read data and reports from the South Heartland District Health Department as well as other sources of information. You can access that data here: https://bit.ly/Data1-21

At our meeting we had a robust discussion about what we could do to help reduce the spread of COVID-19, both in our church family and in our community. The South Heartland District Health Department recommends a "layered approach" to reduce our risk and the spread of this disease. That approach includes face masking, social distancing, good ventilation, and vaccinations and boosters.

As Session assessed the risk, we affirmed that we are taking this layered approach. We require face masks, do our best to facilitate social distancing, have good ventilation in the sanctuary with the UV light filter in our air handler, and we have consistently encouraged our congregation to get their vaccines and boosters. So Session determined that we will continue to take this layered approach to combat this disease in our community, while also continuing to provide a remote option for as many of our activities as possible. That means we will continue worship in-person, as well as Sunday School, committee meetings, and other church activities for now. And we will work to provide a remote option for as many of these activities as we can.

The one gap in our layered approach is when we have events that involve food and people remove their face masks to eat. This includes Wednesday Night Live meals, Funeral Luncheons, Presbyterian Women luncheons, and other events where food is served. To close this gap, Session voted to suspend any events that include food effective today, Friday, January 21. Session will revisit this policy at our next meeting on Thursday, February 17. We hope and pray that the surge has diminished by that time and we will be able to allow events with food.

Thank you for your patience and understanding as we do our best to combat this terrible disease while still seeking to share the love and light of Christ among our own church family, in our community, and out into the world. 


