Dear First Presbyterian Church Family:

What a blessed season of graduations we are celebrating this May! I love this transitional time as our young people and their families reflect back on all of their successes and the hard work that it has taken to get them to this day, while they also look forward to what the future may hold. In theological terms we call this a "liminal space." Think of it like a door frame with one foot in and one foot out.

Our shared faith history gives us a lot of examples of liminal spaces and how we can use those to reflect and stretch towards the future. The Israelites spent 40 years wandering in a liminal space between their enslavement in Egypt and the arrival to the promised land. In this season of Easter, we celebrate the liminal space between Jesus' resurrection and his ascension. Jesus spent weeks in this liminal space walking around and continuing to teach and reinforce his message of love and grace to his disciples before he ascended into heaven to leave that mission to his followers, which includes us!

Our graduates now stand in a liminal space as they move from one season of their life to the next. Some families may be also standing in a liminal space as they prepare to be empty nesters. My hope is that we can fall back on the stories of our faith when we find ourselves in these liminal spaces. May we find comfort and hope from the communion of saints who have come before us and stood in these liminal spaces. And may we be inspired to continue to live our faith boldly as we step across the threshold into something new.

I had the privilege of offering the closing blessing to the Hastings College graduates this year at their graduation ceremony on May 14. I shared one of my favorite benedictions that comes from the Benedictine community that reminds us to find blessings in strange places and to hold out hope as we step out into the world. I hope you find this meaningful as well:

May God bless you with discomfort... at easy answers, half –truths, and superficial relationships, so that you may live deep within your heart

May God bless you with anger... at injustice, oppression, and conflict so that you may work for justice, freedom, and peace.

May God bless you with tears... to shed for those who suffer from pain, rejection, and violence, so that you may reach out your hand to comfort them and turn their pain into joy.

And may God bless you with enough foolishness...

To believe that you can make a difference in the world, so that you can do what others claim cannot be done. To bring kindness, light and love to the world. Amen






