FPC VOLUNTEER OPPORTUNITIES

- Nursery Volunteers. This is a 1 hour commitment on Sunday mornings. We use a rotation schedule so you never work more than one Sunday a month (the more volunteers, the less often you're on the schedule). We are looking for kind, patient, loving people to spend time in the nursery.



- Middle School Youth Group volunteers. This is a 1 hour commitment each Sunday night (6-7pm). We are looking for people who are patient, helpful, and enjoy engaging with 6-8th grade students. Main responsibilities include facilitating conversations and making connections with students.



- Preschool and Kindergarten WNL helpers. This is a 2 hour commitment each Wednesday night. We are looking for people who are high energy, patient, and helpful to assist with our youngest students.



- Volunteers for Wednesday Night Live meals. This is typically a 2 hour commitment. These volunteers prepare the fellowship hall for WNL meal time, plate/serve meals, wash dishes/clean up the kitchen. *There are no cooking requirements for this position (unless you want to take on that responsibility).*



- Confirmation Mentors. We are in need of 7 adults from our congregation to act as mentors to the 8th graders going through confirmation this year. There is a one-page questionnaire to fill out if you are interested. Please reach out to Rose or Damen for more information.

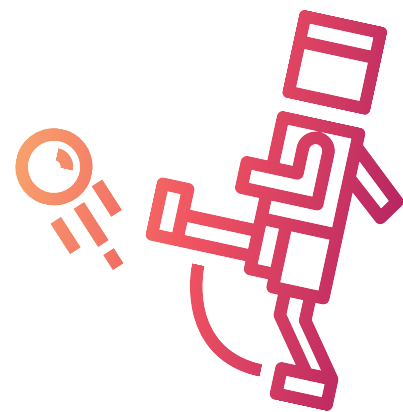

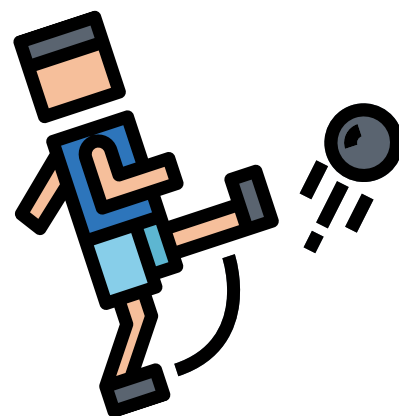

For the past 18 years, our church has partnered with Catholic Social Services by making sack lunches on four Sundays in July to be distributed at Catholic Social Services during the week. We have done this every year, even during church transitions and the pandemic. Once again, we were overwhelmed by the generosity, prayers and energy for Open Table last month. Together, we assembled about 5,000 sacks/sandwiches (1,225 per Sunday). It is a joy to be a part of our church family as we are working together. Not only did we provide needed meals for others, we did it with faith, positive energy, conversation, creativity and humor. Once again, several new members, and people got to work together with people they had not known previously. As is true with any mission project, participation in the Open Table is a blessing to all of us. We expected the numbers to be higher again in July. According to the director at CSS, 2,675 lunches were distributed this month, so we will have provided lunches well into August.

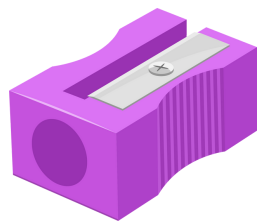

CWS School Kits

School kits give children in impoverished schools, refugee camps, or other difficult settings some of the basic tools for learning.



Here's what you'll need

- One pair of blunt scissors removed from the package (rounded tip, only)
- Three 70-count bound notebooks or notebooks totaling 200-210 pages (no loose-leaf or filler paper)
- One 30-centimeter / 12" ruler
- One hand-held pencil sharpener removed from the package
- One large eraser (no pencil cap erasers)
- Six new, unsharpened pencils with erasers (please remove pencils from the package)
- One box of 24 crayons (only 24)
- One 12"x14" to 14"x17" finished size cotton or lightweight canvas bag with handles (solid color or kid-friendly fabric, no logos, reusable shopping bags or backpacks)



All items must be packed inside of the bag. The MyShopAngel website has an affordable CWS Kit bag for bulk purchase. Visit cwskits.org/bag to order. Or, [download our school bag pattern](#) and make your own! (you do not have to make a bag)


Optional: Loose school kit items may be placed in a large Ziploc type bag to keep them together. Remove the air, seal the bag and place inside of the cotton/canvas bag.
