For the past 18 years, our church has partnered with Catholic Social Services by making sack lunches on four Sundays in July to be distributed at Catholic Social Services during the week. We have done this every year, even during church transitions and the pandemic. Once again, we were overwhelmed by the generosity, prayers and energy for Open Table last month. Together, we assembled about 5,000 sacks/sandwiches (1,225 per Sunday). It is a joy to be a part of our church family as we are working together. Not only did we provide needed meals for others, we did it with faith, positive energy, conversation, creativity and humor. Once again, several new members, and people got to work together with people they had not known previously. As is true with any mission project, participation in the Open Table is a blessing to all of us. We expected the numbers to be higher again in July. According to the director at CSS, 2,675 lunches were distributed this month, so we will have provided lunches well into August.

Langenberg Music Program

You are invited to participate in a very exciting program offered by the First Presbyterian Church, Hastings. Several years ago, through the generosity of the late Luella Langenberg, a program was established to encourage the youth of our church in their musical pursuits.

Parents of students in grades 1-12 may apply for up to \$250 per semester to offset the cost of private music instruction. Applicable areas of study include piano, voice, guitar, or any band/orchestral instrument. Grants are limited to one per child. Parents must be members of First Presbyterian Church and students must be active participants in the church choir/music program.



🕞 Here's what you'll need

- · One pair of blunt scissors removed from the package (rounded tip, only)
- Three 70-count bound notebooks or notebooks totaling 200-210 pages (no looseleaf or filler paper)
- One 30-centimeter / 12" ruler
- · One hand-held pencil sharpener removed from the package
- One large eraser (no pencil cap erasers)
- · Six new, unsharpened pencils with erasers (please remove pencils from the package)
- One box of 24 crayons (only 24)
- One 12"x14" to 14"x17" finished size cotton or lightweight canvas bag with handles (solid color or kid-friendly fabric, no logos, reusable shopping bags or backpacks)
