Dear First Presbyterian Church Family:

I hope and pray that you had a blessed Advent and Christmas season. Here at the church, I thought we had a faithful and meaningful season of anticipation during Advent. It started with our Hanging of the Greens, a Christmas craft event, and a concert by Cathedral Brass. We prayed together all month using our Advent devotional guide and gave generously through the reverse Advent calendar and the Giving Tree. Advent worship included glorious music led by our organist, church choirs and bell choirs, and an incredible children's Christmas program that told us the story of God coming to earth in a delightful and thoughtful way (and it was sure precious to see our children and youth leading worship with such joy!) We also hosted a Blue Christmas service on December 21<sup>st</sup> for people experiencing grief during the holiday season.

Our Christmas Eve services shared the good news of Jesus' birth and what that means for all of us to more than 550 people in our church family, our community, and beyond with the help of our broadcast ministries. We continued our tradition of bringing our Christmas Eve service to the residents of College View retirement community at 2pm with some help from our organist and members of our Chancel Choir. Our 5:30 family service was packed and there were more than 50 children there with their families. Our 7:30 service was full of great music provided by our organist, our choir, and the Cathedral Brass as we reflected on what it means for God to come "in the flesh." Our 11pm contemplative service was beautiful with special music that set the perfect mood to hear the story of Christ's birth. If you've never attended that service, I encourage you to check it out next year.

Christmas Day fell on a Sunday this year, and Pastor Damen led a delightful Christmas Birthday Brunch service in the Fellowship Hall to celebrate the birth of Jesus with more incredible music and reflections on the meaning of Christmas.

It was truly a blessed season in the life of our church. We could not have done it without the support of so many including our amazing church staff, many volunteers, everyone who gave to the Giving Tree and reverse Advent calendar projects, and everyone who showed up to our various events and worship services. Thank you for your support of our beloved church!

We now begin the season of Epiphany which will take us through January and February. I will be preaching a sermon series during this season entitled, "Gifts that keep on giving." With the commercial gift-giving season behind us, this series will focus on some of God's unexpected gifts that we can enjoy long after we put away the Christmas decorations - gifts that reveal themselves in new ways as time goes on. We will focus on gospel readings, including the Sermon on the Mount. Through this series, we will recognize the gifts that God shares with humanity and realize they are ours to receive if we are bold and loving enough to accept them.
