Dear First Presbyterian Church Family:

We have now entered the season of Epiphany, which is that time that falls between Christmas and the season of Lent. The Epiphany event in our bible is the manifestation of Christ to the world in the story of the Magi in Matthew 2:1-12, which Rev. Doodle Harris preached about on January 1st. An "epiphany" is defined as a moment of sudden revelation or insight. So we will spend the next few weeks opening ourselves up to revelations and insights about God.

I am preaching a sermon series entitled "Gifts that Keep on Giving" that will hopefully open our hearts and minds to some of the gifts that God gives us. I'm sure that many of you received and gave gifts around the Christmas holiday. Now that we are past Christmas, and the sometimes overly commercialized gift-giving season, we are going to focus on some of God's unexpected gifts that we can enjoy not just in December, but throughout the year, and throughout our lives. These gifts that we will study over the next six weeks reveal themselves in new ways as time goes on. So, we are going to study the stories in the gospels that mark the start of Jesus' earthly ministry and demonstrate these gifts that god extends to us, and are ours to receive and enjoy if we are bold and loving enough to accept them. On January 8 we studied the gift of "Committed Community" that is found in the baptismal vows we make every time we baptize a member of our church. Last week we studied the curiosity that God gives us to explore our faith and I shared about my daughter's curiosity and her many questions. Next week

we will study the call to bold action as read about Jesus gathering his first disciples in Matthew 4. The following week we will study the gift of prophetic challenge that we find in the Sermon on the Mount in Matthew 5. And we will conclude by reflecting on the gift of outrageous grace that is freely shared with us through the birth, life, ministry, death, and resurrection of Jesus.






