Dear First Presbyterian Church Family:

Some of you may have noticed that the Beto's Tacos food truck is no longer parked in our PEACE Center parking lot. I wanted to share an update with you, as well as a word of gratitude and an exciting announcement.

First, a little history: We were approached by the owner of Beto's, Francisco Diaz, in December of 2020 with a request to park in the PEACE Center parking lot for a monthly fee. Session and Trustees considered and prayed about his request. We also thought about the PEACE Center and our goal to transform it into a **vibrant community center that welcomes our neighbors**. We determined that Francisco and Beto's Tacos would be a good partner in furthering that goal. Starting in March of 2021, Beto's Tacos parked in the PEACE Center parking lot after a long process of prayer and discernment with the Session and Trustees, as well as getting the right permits from the city.

The partnership with Francisco and Beto's Tacos has thrived. Anyone who has bought food there knows that the food is excellent, but just as important, Francisco has a heart of gold and is always friendly and warm, seeing his business as a form of ministry. Through this partnership, we were able to provide a space for a young entrepreneur to start his business AND our PEACE Center parking lot became a **community gathering space**. Last summer we hosted a "Food Truck Roundup" event with Beto's Tacos as the anchor that brought more than 250 people to the PEACE Center. Francisco also donated food to the volunteers who worked at United Harvest each month. The small business grew and flourished and First Presbyterian Church of Hastings further developed our reputation of **welcome, hospitality, and fellowship.**

In a best case scenario for Beto's Tacos, the business has grown and they have now opened a restaurant. It is just two blocks south of the church in the same shopping center as Little Caesars and Imperial Garden. The PEACE Center parking lot served as a **small business incubator** for Beto's Tacos and Francisco. While we will miss having Beto's Tacos in the PEACE Center parking lot, we celebrate Francisco's success and wish him well. On the next page you will see a thank you note that Francisco has written to our congregation.

Last month, we received another request for a food truck to park in the space where Beto's Tacos was parked. On Thursday 4/20/23, Session voted to approve the new food truck to park there, so starting next week, you will see "The Big Pig" barbeque truck parked in the PEACE Center parking lot. In their request, the owners Matt and Amy Schnase wrote, "The Big Pig food truck has been a dream, a journey, and something that has brought our family closer together... In the spring of 2022 we opened our window and began traveling to any small town, tap house, or business that would have us within 2 hours of Hastings. This is when we realized our little dream was a lot more work than we ever thought. Luckily we had our faith and our family to get it done. It's been an amazing adventure! We feel like people can see the love and that positive energy we put out in our food... We feel that the PEACE Center parking lot would allow us to reach out to the people of Hastings from a clean and centralized location and give us the opportunity to continue to grow our dream."

Session is excited for this new partner and sees this as a ministry opportunity to continue to pursue our mission of **welcoming all** and seeking to **transform our community**. I want to thank the church for taking a chance 15 years ago by purchasing the old middle school annex, for investing in the property and the parking lot, and for the great work that has been done in turning the building and the parking lot into a vibrant community center and gathering space.


LONG SLEEVE

Our Little Angels: Our mission is to help families who have experienced infertility or loss during pregnancy & infancy. We donate care packages and provide financial assistance for counseling, medical & funeral expenses. We also offer monthly support groups, ongoing bereavement support & coordinate other services the family may need at this time such as cleaning, meal preparation, fundraisers, memorial registration & funeral planning. We offer our services to Hastings and the surrounding areas.

+<u>Threads of Grace</u>: Threads of Grace strives to relieve some of the stress for children transitioning to a new foster home or enCourage shelter and supply them with basic needs. Our goal is to provide five new outfits for each child. Threads of Grace will partner with retailers to purchase brand new clothing at a discount utilizing donated funds. Additionally, we hope to relieve the initial financial burden many foster families face within the first 24 hours of placement. Future aspirations are to assist local schools with children's emergency needs. It is a nonprofit that serves children birth to 19 years of age who have been placed into foster care or have sought shelter with enCourage in Adams County
