Dear First Presbyterian Church Family:


Last week we mailed an envelope and sent an email to every household in the church that included a letter and a booklet introducing our church's capital campaign. I hope you received the mail or email.

We are raising money to update/remodel parts of our church building and the PEACE Center. The projects your church leaders have selected are around the themes of **being family friendly**, **facilitating hospitality, providing accessibility, ensuring preservation and sustainability.** You can read more details about these projects in the capital campaign booklet or at this website: https://fpchastings.org/capitalcampaign/

On September 17, I introduced the capital campaign during our worship service, and we heard a moving testimonial from John and Cathy Pershing, who are co-chairs of the capital campaign. If you missed that, you can watch it here: <u>https://youtu.be/aDhlZVBW--c</u>

Our goal for this capital campaign is to raise \$2million. That sounds like a lot for a church of our size, and it is. But we are a church that consistently rises to a challenge, and I know we can do this!

I have some exciting news that I shared on Sunday, September 17. It is typical during a major campaign like this to gather with some of our financial leaders before the start of the public portion of the campaign. For the last year, the church leadership and I have been listening to, dreaming with, and praying about where God is leading us. And your fellow church members have responded with incredible hope and generosity.



To date, we have already received \$1.35million in pledges! This is 68% of our goal and represents gifts from 32 families. This is an incredible start to the campaign, and I know that we will be able to finish strong.

Here are a few details about the campaign and what you can expect over the next seven weeks.

- You will hear details and testimonials about the capital campaign in church each week for the next seven weeks
- There will be **gatherings on October 11 and October 12** in the evenings for church members to come and learn more about the campaign and to ask questions.
- **Pledge cards** for the capital campaign and our church's annual stewardship campaign will be **mailed and emailed** to every household in the church the **week of October 16**.

• You will be invited to return your pledge cards on Sunday, November 5.

There are a few important points I want to emphasize as we begin this important and exciting work:

- 1. Gifts to the capital campaign are over and above gifts to our annual giving. It will be critical for us to continue to fund the annual budget to do what God wants us to do in the future.
- 2. Donations to the capital campaign can be given anytime during the next three years. Some people give a lump sum in the beginning. Others give yearly. And others will give monthly for the next 36 months.
- 3. My hope is that we have 150 pledges. One for each year. Every gift matters.

This is a very exciting time for our beloved church as we celebrate 150 years of faithfulness, and we prepare for a future that is full of hope!
