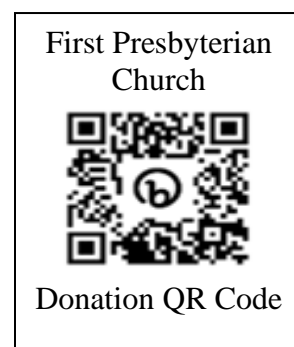
We believe in the God of Christ Jesus, the source of abundance, full of grace and truth.


