Scholarship Requirements and Criteria

Ann L Binfield Scholarship

The criteria for the Ann L Binfield Scholarship require a recipient:

- 1. to be an outstanding student,
- 2. to have financial need*
- 3. to be a member of First Presbyterian Church, Hastings NE
- 4. to attend a Presbyterian college or university.

Amount of the scholarship will vary, depending on the number of applicants. The scholarship will be paid directly to the recipient's college for the 2024-2025 school year.

In addition to the application, each student must also submit the following items to First Presbyterian Church Attn: Scholarship Committee, Tim Redline

- 1. ACT/SAT scores (first application only)
- 2. High school transcript/class rank (first application only)
- 3. College transcript (for renewing application)

Ted and Lori Schroeder Scholarship

The criteria for the Schroeder Scholarship require a recipient:

- 1. to be a member of First Presbyterian Church, Hastings NE
- 2. to be starting their first year at Hastings College or Central Community College Hastings

One scholarship will be awarded for \$1000 and cannot be renewed. The scholarship will be paid directly to the applicant. Preference will be given to students that are not currently receiving an Ann L Binfield Scholarship.

Chip Essex Memorial Scholarship

The criteria for the Chip Essex Memorial Scholarship require a recipient:

- 1. to be a member of First Presbyterian Church, Hastings NE
- 2. to attend a 2 year or 4 year, post-secondary education

One scholarship will be awarded for \$500 and it can be renewed one time only. The scholarship will be paid directly to the applicant. Preference will be given to students that are not currently receiving an Ann L Binfield Scholarship.

Legacy Scholarship

The criteria for the Legacy Scholarship require a recipient:

- 1. to be a member of First Presbyterian Church, Hastings NE
- 2. to be a graduating high school senior
- 3. to attend a 2 year or 4 year, post-secondary education

One scholarship will be awarded for \$1000 and cannot be renewed. The scholarship will be paid directly to the applicant.
