Dear First Presbyterian Church Family:

We had 11 youth stand up and share their statements of faith that they wrote as a culmination of a year of study and reflection on what it means to be a Christian and what it means to be a member of the Church. The wisdom, insight, and faith that they shared was truly inspiring. After hearing the youth speak, I have a great deal of hope for the future of our beloved church!

On Sunday, May 12, we will receive 8 new members in the church. As adults, we don't require our new members to go through a full year of confirmation class like our youth. Instead, they attend 3 weeks of classes and then join the church. You can find their names and photographs in the pages of the newsletter this week. If you see them in Church or out and about around town, please greet them and welcome them.

As part of both the Confirmation class, and the new members class, we review what it means to be a faithful church member. I wanted to share that as a reminder of what we have all committed to as members of First Presbyterian Church of Hastings. Here is the definition of church membership from the Presbyterian Book of Order:

A faithful member bears witness to God's love and grace and promises to be involved responsibly in the ministry of Christ's Church. Such involvement includes: -Proclaiming the good news in word and deed.

-Taking part in the common life and worship of a congregation,

-Lifting one another up in prayer, mutual concern, and active support,

-Studying Scripture and the issues of Christian faith and life,

-Supporting the ministry of the church through the giving of money, time, and talents, -Demonstrating a new quality of life within and through the church,

-Responding to God's activity in the world through service to others,

-Living responsibly in the personal, family, vocational, political, cultural, and social relationships of life,

-Working in the world for peace, justice, freedom, and human fulfillment, -Caring for God's creation,

-Participating in the governing responsibilities of the church, and -Reviewing and evaluating regularly the integrity of one's membership, and considering ways in which one's participation in the worship and service of the church may be increased and made more meaningful.

As we have 19 new members join our beloved church family this month through confirmation and the new members class, join with me in celebrating the growth of our church family! May we all reflect on what it means to be a member of this church and to be part of the Body of Christ. Take sometime this week to "consider ways in which your participation in the worship and service of the church may be increased and made more meaningful." And thank you for being a faithful part of our church family!



Join our congregation in fellowship and service as we celebrate our 21st year of support for the Open Table Sack Lunch Program. For those of you that are new to our church or community, the Open Table Sack Lunch Program is a community wide program providing free daily sack lunches Monday through Friday from 1:00 to 5:00 pm. Beginning Sunday, July 7th, we will be assembling 1,000 lunches during the four Sundays of July in Fellowship Hall preceding or immediately following the Sunday worship services. This tradition in our church has been a blessing for the people receiving the lunches, and the people preparing them. We have continuously supported this community wide program since its inception. The Open Table Communion Offering this month will stay in our church to assist in paying for the sandwiches and other food items for the sacks we prepare.
