PRAYER FOR NEW MEMBERS

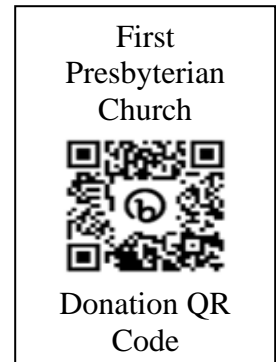
