Music and Mission Trip to the US-Mexico Border with Frontera de Cristo

Dear First Presbyterian Church Family:
Our church has partnered with Frontera de Cristo,
a Presbyterian ministry on the US-Mexico border,
for the last 15 years. We have taken multiple adult
mission trips to the border and we have hosted
members of Frontera de Cristo who have come to
visit us here in Hastings, including our
Presbyterian Mission workers Mark Adams and his
wife Miriam Maldonado.



In October, Frontera de Cristo is celebrating their 40th Anniversary as a Presbyterian Border Ministry. They have invited the members of our church to come participate in the celebration and have our Chancel Choir members provide music as part of a binational choir. Our Mission Committee had already been planning an adult mission trip to the US-Mexico border in 2024, so we have combined the planned trip with this invitation to participate in the 40th anniversary celebration in a "Music and Mission Trip to the US-Mexico Border." We are opening up an invitation for any of our church members to come, you don't have to sing in the choir, you can just come to learn about the border ministry and help celebrate the 40th anniversary of Frontera de Cristo!

We are going to charter a bus for this trip, which will run Wednesday 10/16 – Monday 10/21. We hope you will consider joining us! Here is an itinerary of the trip:

- Wednesday, 10/16: Drive from Hastings to Santa Fe, New Mexico, where we will hold a choir concert.
- Thursday 10/17: Drive from Santa Fe to Douglas, AZ and get settled in.
- Friday 10/18: Learn about the border ministries and hold an Evening Concert in Douglas, AZ with our choir, a pianist from Chiapas and local musicians in the lobby of the historic Gadsen Hotel.
- Saturday 10/19: Explore and learn about the border and border ministries. On Saturday night we will attend an outdoor concert in main plaza of Agua Prieta with a local symphony orchestra, our choir, and a binational choir.
- Sunday 10/20: Participate in bi-national worship service on the border for 40th Anniversary Celebration of Frontera de Cristo and then drive part of the way back to Hastings.
- Monday 10/21: Drive the rest of the way back to Hastings.

The goal is to introduce and orient our church members to Frontera de Cristo and the incredible border ministry happening there, to participate in the 40th Anniversary Celebrations of Frontera de Cristo, to have an incredible musical experience for our church musicians (and hopefully some Hasting College students), and to seek to apply our faith and put a human face to what is happening on the US-Mexico border.

Safety is one of our highest priorities for this trip. If you have any questions about safety, please come talk to me or to any of our church members who have been to visit the US-Mexico border with Frontera de Cristo. The cost is \$200 per person and includes transportation via charter bus, lodging, and food for the trip. The trip is being generously subsidized by music and mission funds. Scholarships/financial support is available for those who desire to attend but have a financial need, come talk with me.




