My new shirt should arrive pretty soon and I'm actually quite excited about it. I would describe it to you if I could but I don't have any idea what it looks like. Even if I wanted and was willing, I couldn't tell you a single thing about its color, its graphic design aesthetic, or even its neckline. Someone else designed it. Someone else picked it out. Until the moment I lay eyes and hands upon it, my new shirt remains a complete mystery to me. The new shirt which I am eagerly anticipating is this year's Go & Serve T-Shirt! I have no need of a new t-shirt. In fact, I actively avoid adding any of them to my dresser. However, I will happily make an exception for this particular piece of cloth.

This will be the sixth Go & Serve T-Shirt to make it into my collection. Not the largest collection, by any means, but anyone who is fortunate enough to have one can tell you just how valuable these particular pieces of fabric are.

First of all, the shirt from any given year represents a unique occurrence in the annals of history. For that week, in that year, a group of faithful disciples gathered themselves together in way and for a purpose that can never be duplicated. All of their living. All of their working. All of their pondering and eating, and laughing, and maybe crying represent a singular instance that had never existed before and will never exist again. The shirt is a sign of an irrevocable bond that cannot be broken.

And finally, these t-shirts are so fundamentally valuable because the truth is that they represent not only the actions of a select group of individuals but also the collective faith and support of an entire congregation. Anyone who adorns themselves with one of these shirts knows, intrinsically, that they carry an entire congregation with them wherever they go. They represent a collective good will and encouragement which bubbles up from an incredibly generous people. This year alone, through our stock sale fundraiser, the members and friends of First Presbyterian Church have contributed \$8,000 to ensure that this year's trip is a rousing success!

For those of you that are new to our church or community, the Open Table Sack Lunch Program is a community-wide program providing free daily sack lunches Monday through Friday from 1:00 to 5:00 pm which are distributed from the Catholic Social Services Office.

Beginning Sunday, July 14, we will be assembling 1,400 lunches a week during the last three Sundays of July in Fellowship Hall preceding or immediately following both Sunday worship services. In addition to Sunday morning assembly, we need drivers to transport sandwiches and sacks to Catholic Social Services when we finish on Sunday. This tradition in our church has been a blessing for the people receiving the lunches, and the people preparing them. We have continuously supported this community-wide program every July since its inception.
