Following my time at the General Assembly, I enjoyed some time away on vacation with my family for a family wedding in Ireland and some travels in Scotland. Thank you to the church for providing me and my family with this time.

While I was gone, I got reports about what was happening back here in Hastings and I am just blown away by the dedication and commitment of our church to serving our community. It is truly a testament to our shared faith and mission. Below are some of the highlights of what we have accomplished in the last four weeks:

Mission and Ministry Highlights

- 1. **Long Sleeve Shirts Collection and Distribution:** We successfully collected and distributed long sleeve shirts to seasonal farm workers, providing them with essential protection and comfort as they labor in the fields.
- 2. **Welcome Meal for Seasonal Farm Workers:** We helped to host a warm and welcoming meal for 150 seasonal farm workers upon their arrival in Hastings. This event not only nourished them physically but also showed our community's hospitality and care.
- 3. **United Harvest Food Distribution:** Through the United Harvest food distribution event, we were able to support over 350 families in our community. This initiative was a crucial effort in addressing food insecurity and demonstrating our commitment to serving those in need.

- 4. **Sack Lunch Assembly for Catholic Social Services:** On three Sundays in July, we came together to assemble over 4,000 sack lunches, which were donated to Catholic Social Services. This effort provided much-needed meals to those experiencing hunger in our area.
- 5. **Go and Serve Mission Trip:** Our youth, along with four dedicated adults, are currently in North Carolina on a mission trip, representing our church in a meaningful and impactful way. We are proud of their service and the difference they are making.
- 6. **Car Show Fundraiser:** The car show held in our parking lot was a great success, raising funds for the food pantry at the middle school. This event not only supported a critical community resource but also brought people together for a fun and engaging day.
- 7. **Fellowship Event at the Water Park:** Our fellowship event at the water park was a wonderful opportunity for our church family to come together with the "Raices de mi Pueblo" Mexican folkloric dancers and their families. It was a beautiful celebration of community and culture, strengthening the bonds between us.

It has been an incredible summer of ministry and mission, and I am so proud to be your pastor. I am excited to be back from my travels and look forward to serving alongside all of you as we continue our journey of faith together.

Food4Thought helps make sure that these students have something to eat before returning to school on Monday morning.
