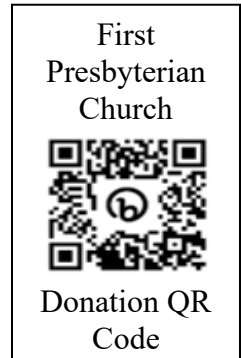
***AFFIRMATION OF FAITH (The Apostle's Creed)**
