The Most Wonderful Time of the Year!

Dear First Presbyterian Church Family:

It is my pleasure to be writing to you this week and to share about my favorite time of the year! From June 23–26, we will be hosting our four-day Vacation Bible School program here at First Pres. I've gone on record saying things like: "VBS is my jam," "VBS is my favorite holiday," "I live for VBS," and "VBS is the best part of my job." While some of those statements might be a bit hyperbolic... the truth remains: I just LOVE Vacation Bible School!

VBS is a special time when we devote hundreds of volunteer hours to teach our children and youth truths about God that will very likely stick with them for a lifetime. (I don't know about you, but I still find myself randomly humming songs I learned in VBS as a child!) This one week in summer can have a profound and lasting impact on a child's faith journey and the way they connect with both God and the Church.

You may not know this, but many churches across the country have discontinued Vacation Bible School in recent years. The reasons vary: a shortage of volunteers, decreased attendance, tight budgets, shifting ministry priorities, or burnout among leaders and staff. That's why it's worth celebrating that none of those challenges are holding us back at First Presbyterian Church. In fact, I'd say quite the opposite is true.

At First Pres, our church family consistently demonstrates a deep commitment to the faith formation of children and youth. That commitment shows up in so many ways: generous financial support, eager and faithful volunteers, and a community culture that values joyful discipleship. Every year, adults show up ready to lead, mentor, and encourage. Every year, our congregation says "yes" to making space for children to experience the good news of God's love. And that is no small thing.

So, what do we have planned for this year's program? I'm glad you asked!

This summer, we'll dive into the theme: **"Scuba diving into friendship with God"** Throughout the week, our children will explore how Jesus is:

- a friend who is *real*,
- a friend who loves,

- a friend for everyone.

Each day will include storytelling, songs, games, crafts, and more—centered around stories from the Gospels and anchored by Proverbs 18:24: "There is a friend who is closer than a brother." We'll also be collecting a special offering throughout the week in support of our church's mission partnership with the United Way, helping provide assistance to local individuals and families who might otherwise fall through the cracks.

Whether you're serving, praying, or cheering us on from afar, thank you for being part of this important work. Together, we are helping plant seeds of faith that will grow for years to come.




Door Codes
