service led by Hannah Jensen-Heitmann, who wrote original songs for this year's Vacation Bible School. With guitar in hand and joy in her heart, she taught these songs to the congregation, helping to prepare us for the week ahead. Pastor Damen and Rose Koepp offered a preview of VBS during the message, walking us through the themes our children would explore. The whole service was a joyful invitation into the faith formation journey of our young disciples.

That evening, we took the joy to the pool! Our Water Park Night at the Hastings Aquacourt welcomed more than 75 people from the church and the wider community. We rented out the whole facility and opened the gates with radical hospitality—offering a night of laughter, splashes, and fellowship. It was a simple, beautiful way to be the church in the world.

From Monday through Thursday, June 23–26, Vacation Bible School came to life! Over 40 children participated, nearly half of whom came from outside our congregation. With the help of our energetic youth and dedicated adult volunteers, we shared the good news that *Jesus is a friend we can trust*. Songs were sung, crafts were made, Bible stories were told, and friendships were formed. We were surrounded by the joyful noise of children learning about God's love—and we were all blessed by their energy and faith.

Then on Sunday, June 29, the week culminated with a powerful and moving worship service.

The band *A Brother's Fountain*, who headlined the Flatwater Music Festival at Prairie Loft, joined us in worship and shared their music. I preached a sermon based on their original song *The Birds Don't Worry*, drawing from Jesus' teaching in Matthew 6:25–34. We were reminded that instead of being consumed by worry, we are invited to seek first the Kingdom of God—a message that resonated deeply after a week filled with Kingdom glimpses. Throughout the week, from worship to water slides, from songs to sermons, from foam parties to faith lessons, we were living into what it means to be a *Kingdom people*. We

worshiped together, played together, learned together, and served together. We welcomed our neighbors, loved our children, and celebrated the joy of being church.

One sack lunch, per person, per day, no questions asked. Join our congregation in fellowship and service as we celebrate our 22nd year of support for the Open Table Sack Lunch Program. For those of you that are new to our church or community, the Open Table Sack Lunch Program is a community-wide program providing free daily sack lunches Monday through Friday from 1:00 to 5:00 pm. Lunches are distributed from the Catholic Social Service Office. Beginning Sunday, July 6th, we will be assembling about 1200 lunches on Sundays preceding or immediately following both Sunday worship services until we have completed our donations. In addition to Sunday morning assembly, we need drivers to transport sandwiches and sacks to Catholic Social Services when we finish on Sunday. This tradition in our church has been a blessing for the people receiving the lunches and the people preparing them. We have continuously supported this community-wide program every July since its inception.
