# **Wrestling with God – The book of Job: Faith, Suffering, and Blessing**

## Adult Education & Sermon Series with Culminating Jazz Concert

Dear First Presbyterian Church Family:

Why do bad things happen to good people? This age-old question has perplexed believers for centuries, and it's at the heart of one of the most profound books in Scripture: The Book of Job. This fall, we invite you to wrestle with this question together through a two-week adult education forum, a sermon series, and a special musical event.

## **Pre-Reading Opportunity**

We have ordered copies of Rabbi Harold Kushner's classic book *The Book of Job: When Bad Things Happen to a Good Person*. You are invited to pick up a copy in the church office and do some pre-reading before the series begins. Pre-reading is not required to participate, but this book is a deeply insightful resource that will enrich your reflection on suffering, faith, and God's presence in the midst of trials.

#### **Adult Education Forum**

Join us in the adult forum during the Sunday school hour (9:15–10:15 a.m.) on September 14 and 21 as we dive into the themes of Job, Kushner's insights, and our own lived experiences of faith and hardship. These classes will be taught by our scholar in residence, Dr. Dan Deffenbaugh.

### Sermon Series: Wrestling with God-Faith, Suffering, and Blessing

I will preach a two-part sermon series that explores Job's trials alongside stories from Genesis, helping us reflect on how people of faith wrestle with God in times of testing and loss.

- September 14: "When the Test Comes"

  Job 1:6-22 & Genesis 22:1-14

  Abraham and Job both face unthinkable tests. How do we respond when we cannot see the purpose behind the pain?
- September 21: "Suffering and Blessing"

  Job 29:1–11 & Genesis 27:1–40; 28:10–17

  Job laments lost blessings, while Jacob gains one through deception. What does it mean to be blessed when life feels broken?


