Memorial Wall

The purpose of the Memorial Wall is to allow for the memorialization of those persons who have had a connectional relationship with First Presbyterian Church. It may be that their remains are interned elsewhere but the family wish the deceased be remembered for their relationship to the Church. A name of remembrance on the Memorial Wall shall be limited in eligibility in the same manner as niche inurnment eligibility.

The Church will arrange at the expense of the donor initiating the memorialization for the engraving of the name on the face plate of the Memorial Wall. The expense will be \$150 plus the cost of engraving and shipping. The location of the names of remembrance will be at the discretion of the Columbarium Committee. Consideration of the costs of engraving will be taken into consideration in that choice. The engraving will be executed in a consistent and uniform manner. Each face plate can accommodate six lines of names.

Policies and Procedures:

Eligibility for inurnment and/or Memorial Wall

Members or former members, affiliate members, pastors and staff of the Church, their or prior spouses or partners, their childcare (natural or adopted) and step-children, their grandchildren, their parents, and ordained First Presbyterian pastors and their current or prior spouses or partners may be inured at the columbarium or memorialized on the Memorial Wall.
